CONTRACT TIME: The entire contract shall be completed in all details and ready for final acceptance in accordance with Subsection 105.17(b) within **one hundred five (105) working days**.

Prior to assessment of contract time, the contractor will be allowed 30 calendar days from the date stipulated in the Notice to Proceed to commence with portions of the contract work including but not limited to assembly periods, preparatory work for materials fabrications such as test piles, or other activities which hinder progress in the beginning stages of construction. Prior to issuance of the Notice to Proceed, the Department will consider extending the assembly period upon written request from the contractor justifying the need for additional time.

The contractor shall be responsible for maintenance of traffic from the beginning of the assembly period. During the assembly period, the contractor will be allowed to do patching and other maintenance work necessary to maintain the roadway with no time charges when approved by the engineer.

If the contractor begins regular construction operations prior to expiration of the assembly period, the assessment of contract time will commence at the time construction operations are begun.

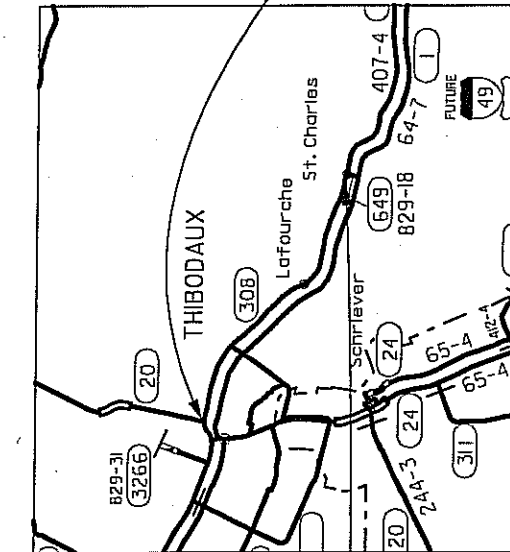

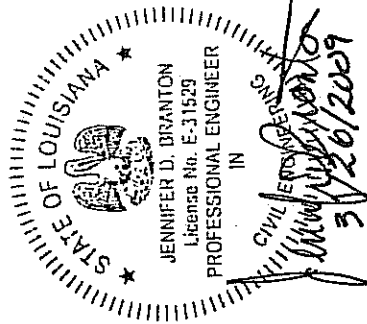

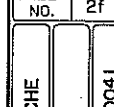

GENERAL CONSTRUCTION NOTES

1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE FOR AND MAINTAIN THROUGH AND LOCAL TRAFFIC AT ALL TIMES AND SHALL CONDUCT OPERATIONS IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO CAUSE THE LEAST POSSIBLE INTERFERENCE WITH TRAFFIC AND BUSINESSES.
2. CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN DRAINAGE AT ALL TIMES. ANY MATERIAL DEPOSITED IN ANY DRAINAGE FEATURE (DITCHES, CROSDRAINS, ETC.) DURING CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE CLEANED OUT BEFORE FINAL ACCEPTANCE. SEE SECTION 105.15 AND 701.10(b) OF THE 2006 LOUISIANA DOTD STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROADS AND BRIDGES.
3. THE ITEM FOR ADJUSTING CATCH BASINS WILL INCLUDE ALL ADJUSTMENTS PER CATCH BASIN REQUIRED ITEM NO. 702-04-00200. ITEM NO. 702-04-00200 TO BE USED AS DETERMINED AND DIRECTED BY PROJECT ENGINEER.
4. REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT OF BROKEN CURB WILL BE AS DIRECTED BY THE PROJECT ENGINEER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PLANS. THE MINIMAL REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT WILL BE 36 INCHES AT EACH LOCATION. ALL COST FOR REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT TO BE INCLUDED IN ITEM NO. 202-02-06140 AND 707-01-00100.
5. CONTRACTOR SHALL CONDUCT COLD PLANING AND LAYDOWN OPERATIONS SO THAT NO MORE THAN A 2" DROP OFF EXISTS AT ANY LOCATION WHILE OPEN TO TRAFFIC. ANY TEMPORARY RAMPS FOR TURNOUTS AND/OR DRIVEWAYS TO BE AS DIRECTED BY PROJECT ENGINEER AND PAID FOR BY PRICE BID FOR ITEM NO. 502-01-00200.
6. THE CONTRACTOR WILL CONSTRUCT A FULL DEPTH, VERTICAL CUT, PERPENDICULAR TO THE CENTERLINE AT THE BEGINNING AND END OF THE COLD PLANING AREAS. ALSO, THE CONTRACTOR WILL PROVIDE A PAPER JOINT 3-FOOT IN LENGTH PER INCH OF CUT WITH HOT OR COLD MIX AS DIRECTED BY THE PROJECT ENGINEER. VERTICAL CUTS AND PAPER JOINTS TO BE INCLUDED IN ITEM 509-01-00100, COLD PLANING ASPHALTIC PAVEMENT.
7. THE MILLING OPERATIONS WILL BE LIMITED TO A MAXIMUM DISTANCE 3 MILES AHEAD AND/OR 15 CALENDAR DAYS IN FRONT OF THE ASPHALT BINDER OR WEARING OPERATION.
8. ALL EXISTING REUSABLE SIGNS & POSTS FROM REPLACEMENT OF OBJECT MARKERS AND DEAD END INSTALLATIONS ARE TO BE DELIVERED TO THE RACELAND MAINTENANCE UNIT AS DIRECTED BY THE PROJECT ENGINEER.
9. CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT AND COORDINATE WORK WITH ALL UTILITIES LOCATED IN PROJECT AREA. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE 14 DAYS NOTICE TO UTILITY COMPANIES PRIOR TO BEGINNING WORK. ANY DAMAGE DONE TO UTILITIES SHALL BE REPAIRED AT NO COST TO THE DEPARTMENT. SEE SECTION 107.20 OF THE 2006 LOUISIANA DOTD STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROADS AND BRIDGES.
10. ALL STRIPING SHALL CONFORM TO DOTD STD. PLAN PM-01.
11. NOTES FOR LOOP DETECTORS:
 -LOOP LEAD-INS TO BE SPLICED INTO EXISTING CONDUIT. LOCATING THE EXISTING C-CONDUITS AND/OR SPLICES SHALL BE LOCATED BY THE CONTRACTOR PRIOR TO COLD PLANING OPERATION.
 -ANY DIMENSIONS SHOWN MAY NOT BE EXACT.
 -CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY DOTD TRAFFIC OPERATIONS AFTER LOCATING EXISTING C-CONDUITS AND/OR SPLICES PRIOR TO COLD PLANING THESE AREAS.
 -EXISTING LOOPS ARE LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTIONS WITH AUDUBON ST. (60FT.) AND LA 20 (60 FT.).
